PART II - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

1. Interest in real property located within the jurisdiction including property located within a two mile radius of any property owned or used by the District.

Investments, business positions and sources of income of the type which manufactures or sells supplies, machinery or equipment of the type utilized by the District.

Investments and business positions in any business entity or income from any source if the business entity or source of income is a contractor or subcontractor engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the District.

Consultants shall disclose all sources of income, interests in real property and investment and business positions in business entities.

The Manager of the District may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position", is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties, and based upon that description, a statement to the extent of the disclosure shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.
